A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINE TO THE SAN LUIS VALLEY

WHEREAS Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association has identified a critical need to increase electrical capacity to the San Luis Valley, and

WHEREAS Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association proposes to build a 230-kilovolt transmission line between the Walsenburg and San Luis Valley Substations, and

WHEREAS the proposed transmission line will upgrade the existing transmission system in the San Luis Valley, improve system reliability, help prevent voltage collapse under peak loads, and provide necessary transmission support for renewable energy development in the San Luis Valley.


